Security training in accordance with § 8 Aviation Security Act in conjunction with the EU Regulation No. 2015/1998

Information from Flughafen Köln/Bonn GmbH

The EU Commission regulation no. 2015/1998, which came into force on 01. February 2016, specifies detailed measures for carrying out common basic standards in air security.

Coupled with issuing access authorization for the areas of a commercial airport generally not accessible to the public, and along with reliability checks on staff in accordance with § 7 Aviation Security Act, a training course in accordance with 11.2.6. of the Regulation no. 2015/1998 (four training units) is obligatory.

Places in the courses can be booked at Airport Security, stating the personal data of the participant and sending a reliability screening (PDF / Fax) and invoice address.

Excerpt from EU regulation (EG) no. 2015/1998

11.2.6. Training of persons, other than passengers, who require unaccompanied access to security areas.

11.2.6.1. Persons, other than passengers, who require unaccompanied access to security areas and who do not fall under the categories 11.2.3 - 11.2.5 and 11.5, shall receive security awareness training before they receive authorization for unaccompanied access to security areas.

The certificate of security training must be presented before an Airport ID can be issued.

Please register your new members of staff as soon as possible, if possible directly after receiving the reliability check report.

The costs arising from participating in the security training can be seen in our list of fees on our website www.koeln-bonn-airport.de.

Please note that, due to official stipulations, unaccompanied access authorization to the security areas of Cologne Bonn Airport, generally not accessible to the public, cannot be granted without participation in security training.

An Airport identification card can only be issued after a valid reliability screening has been submitted and the security training courses have been completed.
